We reserve the right to update and change these protocols at any time due to new CDC guidelines or other changes to the current Covid status in our community.



FOR ALL LIVE CLASSES - UPDATED FOR JUNE 1ST 2022

1. All teachers and staff are fully vaccinated.
2. Class sizes will be kept small.
3. Classroom practices are modified to create work spaces for individuals and allow distance between students.
4. **All children and teens classes are MASK OPTIONAL CLASSES. If this policy should change we will let you know.**
5. **All adults ARE REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF OF VACCINATION. Masks will be required when students are watching work being presented. If this policy should change we will let you know. PROOF CAN BE OBTAINED USING <https://gogetdoc.com/vaxyes> This is FREE to do. You DO NOT need to purchase the offers at the end of the process to obtain the digital card.**
6. Anyone showing any symptoms of Covid-19 are asked to stay home.
7. Anyone having been exposed to someone with Covid-19 and has not received a negative Covid test are asked to stay home.
8. Anyone with a positive Covid test must stay home. You can return to class when you have a negative Covid test result.
9. All students will use hand sanitizer at the door upon arrival, or head to the bathroom to wash their hands.
10. Anyone exhibiting Covid symptoms during class will be removed from the activities. If it is a minor, parents will be called to come pick up the student. Adult students will be asked to go home. You can return to live class when your symptoms have passed or you have proof of a negative Covid test.
11. If we are made aware of a positive Covid test for a student or teacher who was in attendance with other students during a potential exposure period, we will contact all students potentially exposed and make you aware of any schedule changes, if any, that might occur due to the positive case.
12. There is no eating allowed in class.

13. You may have a water bottle in class. Please bring your own bottle and take it home with you. Any bottles left behind will be thrown away.

14. Masks and hand sanitizer is available for you at the studio should you need either.

15. The staff will clean and disinfect between each class, including chairs, the floor, the stage, the door handles, equipment, bathrooms, set pieces and counter tops.

16. We will not be allowing the normal use of communal props in the studio. We will provide disposable paper products when necessary. All other props a student may need they will be asked to bring from home. Students will handle only their props. Students will not share props.

17. Class lessons are adjusted to manage the typical closeness and intimacy of working with others actors. There will be more closeness allowed between vaccinated actors who are comfortable with it. We are encouraged about the idea that our techniques and skills can be taught with these restrictions in place. While it may be different for all of us, it is doable and we are giving 100% to have the best and most productive classes during this time.

18. Paper scripts will be given. Please take them home with you. Paper left behind will be disposed of.

19. We will post material at times online and you are welcome to print it at home for class yourselves.

20. In the event of a pandemic related shutdown that affects our ability to offer live classes, the classes will become virtual until any restrictions are lifted and we agree that it safe to return to class live.

21. Anyone who is not comfortable with this set of protocols and does not want to continue with enrollment, please do not register. We fully understand your concerns and do not want you to participate in a facility that you are not comfortable in or do not agree with.
