THE COMPANY ACTING STUDIO COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

We are so glad you enrolled at The Company Acting Studio. Please review the Covid Safety protocols of the studio.

We reserve the right to update and change these protocols at any time due to new CDC guidelines or other changes to the current Covid status in our community.



FOR ALL LIVE CLASSES

- 1. All teachers and staff are fully vaccinated, and will remain fully masked.
- 2. Class sizes will be kept small.
- 3. Classroom practices are modified to create work spaces for individuals and allow distance between students.
- 4. All children and teens are required to wear masks to class. If this policy should change we will let you know.
- 5. All adults are required to wear masks to class. If this policy should change we will let you know.
- 6. Anyone showing any symptoms of Covid-19 are asked to stay home and Zoom into class. Upon arriving to class you will be asked how you are feeling and if you are having any symptoms.
- 7. Anyone having been exposed to someone with Covid-19 and has not received a negative Covid test are asked to stay home and Zoom into class.
- 8. Anyone with a positive Covid test must stay home and can zoom into class. You can return to class when you have a negative Covid test result.
- 9. All students will use hand sanitizer at the door upon arrival, or head to the bathroom to wash their hands.
- 10. Anyone exhibiting Covid symptoms during class will be removed from the activities. If it is a minor, parents will be called to come pick up the student. Adult students will be asked to go home. You can return to live class when your symptoms have passed or you have proof of a negative Covid test.
- 11. If we are made aware of a positive Covid test for a student who was in attendance with other students during a potential exposure period, we will contact all students potentially exposed. If it is a class of students who are too young to be vaccinated, we will close that live class for one week and hold it virtually before returning live the following week. If it is a class of older students, those unvaccinated are asked to stay home and Zoom for one week, vaccinated students will be allowed to return live.
- 12. There is no eating allowed in class.

- 13. You may have a water bottle in class and remove your mask to drink from it. Please bring your own bottle and take it home with you. Any bottles left behind will be thrown away. We will have bottled water for sale at the studio.
- 14. Masks and hand sanitizer is available for you at the studio should you need either.
- 15. The staff will clean and disinfect between each class, including chairs, the floor, the stage, the door handles, equipment, bathrooms, set pieces and counter tops.
- 16. We will not be allowing the normal use of communal props in the studio. We will provide disposable paper products when necessary. All other props a student may need they will be asked to bring from home. Students will handle only their props. Students will not share props.
- 17. Class lessons are adjusted to manage the typical closeness and intimacy of working with others actors. There will be more closeness allowed between vaccinated actors who are comfortable with it. We are encouraged about the idea that our techniques and skills can be taught with these restrictions in place. While it may be different for all of us, it is doable and we are giving 100% to have the best and most productive classes during this time.
- 18. Paper scripts will be given. Please take them home with you. Paper left behind will be disposed of.
- 19. We will post material at times online for our older students and adults and you are welcome to print it at home for class yourselves.
- 20. Zoom invitations will be sent to all students prior to class so you will have it already in the event you develop symptoms last minute.
- 21. In the event of a pandemic related shutdown that affects our ability to offer live classes, the classes will become virtual until any restrictions are lifted and we agree that it safe to return to class live.
- 22. Anyone who is not comfortable with this set of protocols and does not want to continue with enrollment, please do not register. We fully understand your concerns and do not want you to participate in a facility that you are not comfortable in or do not agree with.
